After the service refreshments consisting of tea/coffee, sandwiches, and cakes, will be available in the Brethren's Hall at a cost of £5 per head for those who pre-order it on the return slip below.

Our Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master is very keen to see all Provinces hold such services which give us an opportunity to demonstrate to our families and friends what being a Knight Templar Mason is all about.
